- title of your paper and the abstract.

#### **FORMATTING INSTRUCTIONS OF THE PAPER**

**Font:** Times New Roman

**Spacing:** single

**Margins:** 2,5 cm on all sides. To push the text, please use the tab key (1,25 cm), not the space bar.

**Comments in the text:** please, use at the end of the text "Footnotes".

Authors are fully responsible for the content of the paper, including copyright and stylistic revision.

## **Structure of the paper:**

- *Title of the paper* 14 pt, all capital letters, bold, centred
  - skip 2 lines
- Name and surname of the author 12 pt, centred Make comment under the text (footnote) and include name, surname and titles of the author/authors, address, institution, telephone number and e-mail address 10 pt.
- skip 3 lines
- *Abstract in English or German language* 10 pt, italics, maximum is 10 lines
  - skip a line
- *Key words in English or German language* –10 pt, italics, maximum is 10 words (phrases)
  - skip 2 lines
- $\bullet$  Text of the paper 12 pt, keep the first line of every new paragraph 1,25 cm from the margin
  - skip a line
- Bibliography (norm ISO 690) 12 pt, alphabetical order
