It prepares reviews for monographs, textbooks, scientific papers, research tasks related to public administration.

IX.2 Other activities

In 2014, as part of the National Education Program of the EU in the Slovak Republic, it provided training for components of the integrated rescue system.

Performs training for employees of the Ministry of Defense of the Slovak Republic and for members of the Police Force (Alien Police) to Act no. 71/1967 Coll. on administrative proceedings (administrative order) as amended.

Implements training for employees of local government (chief inspectors, mayors, mayors) focused on public administration issues.
