	One of the areas of legal regulation of the Civil Code, which has not changed at all since the major amendment of 1991, with the exception of the extent of the moderate amendment of 2007, is the regulation of unjust enrichment. The aim of the article was to point out the need for conceptual, systemic, as well as some substantive changes in civil law regulation in this specific area. The author focused on the focal aspects of proposed adjustments of unjust enrichment in the government proposal for an amendment to the Civil Code published in 2018. Applying comparison, analysis and synthesis, the interpretation of the issue the author focused on the issues of conception and systematic inclusion of the institute in question, as well as on its standardized content.
