The paper points to propaganda and disinformation in cyberspace, where it has the potential to influence election results, increase social tensions, and lead to denial of scientific facts about immunization or climate change. Disinformation that is manipulated or fabricated, in addition to highly realistic video or audio clips, has the potential to take this problem to the next, higher level. Experts are already warning that the tools of current propaganda could threaten national security, democracy and world order. Given the cross-border dimension of disinformation, its adverse effects require a coordinated and long-term approach to solving this problem. The paper focuses on selected aspects of propaganda at the level of the European Union.
